It is hereby notified that the Hon'ble Chancellor under Section 24 (1) of Jai Narain Vyas University Act 1962 as amended from time to time has assented to **Ordinance No. 317** for open selection for teachers as detailed below and communicated by the Principal Secretary to Governor, Rajasthan vide his letter No.एफ. 2(6)आरबी/2007-पार्ट/5226 दिनांक 30 जून, 2017:-

ORDINANCE 317
(FOR OPEN SELECTION)

Minimum qualifications for the post of Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors in Subjects (other than Management, Engineering and technology), Directors, Deputy Director and Assistant Director of Physical Education, Librarians, Deputy Librarians, Assistant Librarians for appointment through open selection shall be in accordance with the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities and Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher education 2010 as amended from time to time as prescribed herein under the Ordinance

(1) PROFESSOR

**ARTS, HUMANITIES, SCIENCES, SOCIAL SCIENCES, COMMERCE,
LANGUAGES, LAW, JOURNALISM and MASS COMMUNICATION**

A. (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.

(ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level

(iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process

(iv) A minimum score for Academic Performance Indicator (API) as stipulated in table IIB of Appendix III of the University Grants Commission on minimum qualifications for appointment and other academic staff in Universities and Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher education (4th Amendment), Regulations, 2016. Hereafter called the UGC (4th Amendment), Regulations, 2016.

The minimum score for API to be calculated as per category II and III given in table I of Appendix III of the UGC (4th Amendment), Regulations, 2016.

B. An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has

PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST NORMS
a. Subject to the provisions of these regulations, all candidates who are required to undertake the physical fitness test shall be required to produce a medical certificate certifying that he/she is medically fit before undertaking such tests.
b. On production of such certificate mentioned in sub-clause (a) above, the candidate would be required to undertake the physical fitness test in accordance with the following norms:

12 MINUTES RUN/WALK TEST
Upto 30 years 1800 metres
Upto 40 years 1500 metres
Upto 45 years 1200 metres
Upto 50 years 800 metres
NORMS FOR WOMEN
08 MINUTES RUN/WALK TEST
Upto 30 years 1000 metres
Upto 40 years 800 metres
Upto 45 years 600 metres
Upto 50 years 400 metres
NOTE: The above norms are as per section 4.6.4 of UGC Regulations, 2010 as amended

from time to time.
LIBRARIAN
i. Master's Degree in Library Science/Information Science/documentation with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC seven points scale and consistently good academic record
ii. At least thirteen years as a Deputy Librarian in the University or eighteen years' experience as a College Librarian
iii. Evidence of innovative library service and organization of published work.
iv. Desirable: M.Phil./Ph.D. Library Science/Information Science/documentation/archives and manuscript-keeping
v. A minimum score for Academic Performance Indicator (API) as stipulated in table VIII B of Appendix III of the UGC (4 th Amendment), Regulations, 2016. The API to be calculated as per category II & III given in Table VII of Appendix III of the UGC (4 th Amendment), Regulations, 2016.
DEPUTY LIBRARIAN
i. Master's Degree in Library Science/Information Science/documentation with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC seven points scale and consistently good academic record
ii. Five years' experience as an Assistant Librarian the University/ College Librarian
iii. Evidence of innovative library service and organization of published work and professional commitment, computerization of library
iv. Desirable: M.Phil./Ph.D. Library Science/Information Science/documentation/archives and manuscript-keeping/computerization of library.
v. A minimum score for Academic Performance Indicator (API) as stipulated in table VIII B of Appendix III of the UGC (4 th Amendment), Regulations, 2016. The API to be calculated as per category II & III given in Table VII of Appendix III of UGC (4 th Amendment), Regulations, 2016.
ASSISTANT LIBRARIAN
i. A Master's Degree in Library Science/Information Science/Documentation Science or an equivalent professional degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and a consistently good academic record with knowledge of computerization of library.
ii. Qualifying in the national level test conducted for the purpose by the UGC or any other agency approved by the UGC.
iii. The candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the "University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum

eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of University Assistant Librarian.

“Provided further, the award of degrees to candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ By laws/ Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent position in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions: -

- (a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- (b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- (c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- (d) Candidate has published two research papers from his / her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- (e) The candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/Seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work;

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/ Pro-Vice-Chancellor/ Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University Instructions)”

GENERAL NOTE:

1. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually/differently-abled) /Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
2. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) will be required at the Master's level for those recruited as teachers at any level from industries and research institutions and at the entry level of Assistant Professors, Assistant Librarians, Assistant Directors of Physical Education. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.
4. The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
5. Weightages in selection committee to be considered along with other specified eligibility qualifications as stipulated in this ordinance should be in accordance of Appendix III Table II(B), V(B) and VIII(B) as per 4th Amendment, Regulations, 2016 of UGC (Minimum qualifications for appointment and other academic staff in Universities and Colleges and measures for maintenance of standards in Higher Education.
6. The norms for counting of Past Services for Direct Recruitment shall be as per section 10.1 of UGC regulations, 2010 as amended from time to time.
7. In case of any deviation/ discrepancy in the above ordinance with reference to UGC regulation 2010 including amendments notified in the Gazettes, the Gazette version shall prevail.

GOOD ACADEMIC RECORD (FOR DIRECT RECRUITMENT)

Good academic record means an average of at least 55% marks in three examinations preceding to the Master's degree with at least 50% marks in graduation and any one of the

Secondary/high School, Hr. Secondary/ Sr. Secondary or equivalent grades in the point scale wherever grading system is followed without including any grace marks and/or rounding off to make it 55% or 50% as the case may be.

SEVEN POINTS SCALE

It is clarified that where the University/ College/ Institution declare results in grade points which is on a scale of seven, the following mechanism will be referred to ascertain equivalent marks in percentage:
